The beautiful and quintessential freestone trout stream - the Big Blackfoot River - a River Runs Through It - is only 20 minutes from these cabins. Other local waters include the Clark Fork River just 10 minutes away and the Bitterroot River is less than an hour. Recreation opportunities galore in this lightly populated/developed area of Western Montana including trout fishing, big game hunting, hiking, riding, wildlife viewing and much more.

This true Montana property has 3 separate living areas/cabins including the cozy log sided main cabin with 1 bedroom, 1 bath nice sized living room and full size kitchen that can be a comfortable year around home or provide rental income, the second cabin is an almost new, very cute and decorated western style guest/family cabin with bunk beds, a nice small kitchen and bath with shower, the third cabin is the completely comfortable separate owner's quarters home with several sleeping areas, kitchen and bath with a shower.
